- 2. knack (noun) - chapter 21, pg. 102**
  - an ability, talent, or special skill needed to do something
  
- 3. presumption (noun) - chapter 23, pg. 113**
  - a belief that something is true even though it has not been proved
  
- 4. fixate (verb) - chapter 24, pg. 118**
  - to look at or think about something constantly; to give all of your attention to something
  
- 5. penance (noun) - chapter 26, pg. 128**
  - something that you do or are given to do in order to show that you are sad or sorry about doing something wrong
  
- 6. confines (noun) - chapter 27, pg. 129**
  - the limits or edges of something
  
- 7. relay (verb) - chapter 28, pg. 135**
  - to pass (something, such as a message or information) from one person or device to another

  - to behave in a certain way

  - to interrupt what someone else is saying (with a comment, remark, etc...)

- to try to help settle an argument or disagreement between two or more people or groups

**11. subdued (adjective) - chapter 34, pg. 167**

- not strong, loud, intense, etc.

**12. immaculate (adjective) - chapter 36, pg. 174**

- perfectly clean

**13. publicity (noun) - chapter 37, pg. 182**

- attention that is given to someone or something by newspapers, magazines, television news programs, etc.

**14. conviction (noun) - chapter 39, pg. 193**

- the feeling of being sure that what you believe or say is true

**15. federal (noun) - chapter 40, pg. 197**

- of or relating to a form of government in which power is shared between a central government and individual states, provinces, etc.

**16. invoke (verb) - Chapter 40, pg. 198**

- to mention (someone or something) in an attempt to make people feel a certain way or have a certain idea in their mind
